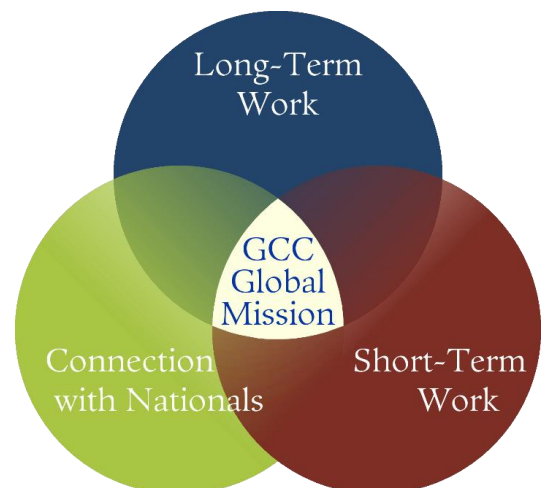
Why We Send G.O. Teams
