We are glad you are applying to participate in this Glenwood Community Church global outreach (G.O.) team to Slovenia. This team will be traveling August 1-15, 2018 and will be participating in leading an English Camp targeted at middle school aged students, in partnership with the Josiah Venture team in Celje, Slovenia. Each team member will be responsible to help raise the financial support for this trip, which is approximately \$2400 per person (which may change somewhat based on airline prices).

The goal for our team is to share the life and love of Jesus Christ through relationships while we work on the designated project.
