
BORN AGAIN TO LASTING HOPE

- What role do trials play in the salvation that we have (v. 6-7)? How have you seen this play out in your life? How might this change your perspective on the challenges you face?
- What is the role of faith in this text? What would exercising faith in these truths look like?
- How do verses 10-12 help make Peter's point?
- How does Peter's panoramic picture of salvation give you hope? Spend time praising God in prayer for His full and certain salvation!
