

GOSPEL INSPIRED GENEROSITY

PHILIPPIANS 4:10-14

GETTING STARTED

• Before you jump into the passage, share a story about a time when God provided for you in some way this week or last. It could be big or small!

SCRIPTURE STUDY

Before you begin: Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter into your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- Have someone read the passage aloud and note any observations, questions, and exciting insights you found while reading through the text to share with the group. What jumped out at you? What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- How is it that Paul is able to rejoice in the Lord even in the midst of his present difficulty?
- Paul talks about depending on God in times where he is "brought low" but what does it look like to depend on God when we are "abounding?" (v12)
- What does it mean to be "Strengthened by God?" How do we obtain this mindset and concept as believers? (v13)

WRAPPING UP

• How are we finding God as a source of joy in this season of our lives? What does it look like practically to share in the trouble of one another when we are in hardship?
