SCRIPTURE STUDY

Before you begin: *Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.*

- Have someone read the passages in their entirety aloud. As a group, summarize the passage, and as you do so, note any observations, questions, and exciting insights you found while reading through the text. What jumped out at you? What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- Quickly look through Hebrews 11:7-38 to understand verse 39 in its context. Talk about someone you have known that displayed faith like these people. Living by faith without seeing the promises of God
- Why do you think the author of Hebrews describes faith as a race?
- How come Jesus went to the cross with joy?
- How does looking to Jesus cause us not to grow weary or faint of heart during this race of faith?
- Take some time to talk to one another about where you sensed the presence of Jesus most throughout your day today. Where did you sense him the least?
