DISCIPLESHIP QUESTIONS

- Talk about a time where you felt judged. It could be in a court of law, a time you were disciplined, maybe even from your in-laws! How did the judgment make you feel? how did you react to the judgment? Was it fair/unfair?
- What does it mean to judge? What type of judgment is Jesus talking about in these verses?
- Are believers to judge? What does it mean in verse 1 when Jesus says, "...so that you will not be judged" after negating judging?
- What do you think causes us to fail in seeing the sin in our own life? How come it is so easy to point out the failures in other people?
- What is the meaning of Matthew 7:6? What/who do the dogs and pigs refer to? How would you describe the character of these kinds of people? What is sacred? What do pearls refer to? What kind of people are we not to share precious truths with?
