### **SCRIPTURE STUDY**

- Do you think James is addressing actual murders and theft for his believing audiences? What does James reveal about how we ask and what we seek as individuals?
- What does James mean when he says that to be a friend of the world is to be an enemy of God?
- Why is God's opposition to pride met with grace to the humble?
- What does James mean when he tells us to draw near to God? What might that look like in your life? (Don't just say more prayer and Bible. Go deeper)
- What does it look like to humble yourself before the Lord?
