DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- How does Proverbs 16:1-9 help us to reflect on our plans and God's plans? Should Christians make plans? Explain.
- Contrast 16:5 and 16:6. Why might these verses be right next to each other? How might the gospel fit into that contrast?
- What is Prov. 22:26–27 teaching? Does this mean that Christians never co-sign loans? Why or why not?
- Contrast Prov. 23:4–5 with 24:3–4. What is the tension between these two passages? How might you resolve it?
- Read Prov. 28:24-25. Discuss how sinful habits and attitudes in one area affects other areas of life. What are these verses teaching?
- Look at Prov. 30:7-9. What is this passage teaching? Have you found these verses to be true in your own life (poverty, abundance, etc.)? How might these verses intersect with our world and culture today?
- Are there overlapping themes or ideas in these Proverbs?
 How do creaturely limitations fit into them?
- How might you apply this sermon and these passages to your life right now? What are the implications?
