## **GETTING STARTED**

• Talk about a time when you struggled to trust Jesus with something. What was the circumstance? How did you get through that time?

## **SCRIPTURE STUDY**

**Before you begin:** Open with prayer and spend a minute or two in silence before God. Have multiple people ask the Holy Spirit to enter your time together and illuminate your hearts and minds to scripture.

- Have someone read the passage in its entirety aloud. As a group, summarize
  the passage, and as you do so note any observations, questions, and exciting
  insights you found while reading through the text. What jumped out at you?
   What was something you noticed now that you didn't see before?
- What does Jesus mean when he says "I AM the way the truth and the life?"
- In this passage, What does Jesus reveal about himself in regard to the relationship with the Father?
- What does Jesus mean when he says that "I am in the Father and the Father is in Me?"
- How do believers do "greater works" than Jesus? (v12)
- When Jesus says that we are to "ask anything in his name" and he will do it, does this mean we can get anything we want? why/why not?

## **WRAPPING UP**

• Throughout the Gospel of John, the theme of "abiding" is something that marks the life of a disciple who is connected to Jesus. What does abiding with Jesus look like for you this season? Have you been feeling disconnected from Him? If so what might it look like to develop new rhythms for abiding? (How might our LIFEgroup keep us accountable in these areas)
