
HONORING JESUS FROM THE INSIDE OUT

SERMON QUESTIONS

- When Peter says, "To sum up..." what is he referring to and to whom is he speaking?
- What do the qualities in v. 8 have in common? How has Peter spoken of them already?
- What reasons does Peter give in v. 9-12 for why we should bless and not retaliate?
- What temptations do you face when being wronged? How does Peter address those?
- How is what's happening inside of us (heart, conscience) affect how we behave?
- How are you provided opportunities to give a reason for the hope that is in you?
- In what way does this challenge you the most: the attitude we are to have (v. 8), resisting retaliation (v. 9-12) or righteous suffering (v. 13-17)? Share specifics for help in prayer.
