- Talk about a time in your life when you experienced discipline from your parents? Was it unfair? Has there ever been a time in your life when you feel like the LORD has disciplined you? What was that experience like?
- Based on what we have talked about and read, what does it look like for followers of Jesus to make wise decisions in their life?
