
WHAT THE GOSPEL GROWS

- Discuss the list of things that Peter says to put aside in 2:1. What do they share? How do they relate with the verses before and after?
- What is this "pure, spiritual milk" (2:2)? Look for clues and help within the text itself.
- How are holiness and love related in this text?
- Discuss the importance of craving and desires for spiritual growth in the Christian life.
- How has this pandemic affected the fervency of your love and spiritual hunger?
