
JESUS INVITES OUTSIDERS TO LOVE HIM

- What is the background of Peter's vision (see Lev. 11; 20:24–26) and what does he learn from it?
- What does God's direct involvement in this event (visions, directions, etc.) teach us?
- How is this scene a fulfillment of God's promise?
- Why is it important that God's will is indisputable?
- How does this text show God's praiseworthy character?
- Does the church struggle with partiality? Do you? Who might be modern day "outsiders"?
- How do we subtly rebuild barriers that God has destroyed through the gospel of Jesus Christ?
