
PRISONER FOR CHRIST

- How is this final scene similar to the rest of the book of Acts? Why is this a fitting conclusion?
- How does God's sovereign control over Paul's life and ministry affect how you think and live in these complicated times?
- How has God used the book of Acts as a whole to challenge, encourage and equip you?
